Description:      Early Hearing Detection and Intervention (EHDI) national goals promote hearings screening for all newborns before one month of age; diagnostic audiological evaluation as early as possible, but no later than three years of age, for those who did not pass the screening; and enrollment in early intervention services as early as possible, but no later than six (6) months of age, for those identified with hearing loss. In order to determine the impact of hearing loss on children and their families and the quality of services they receive, every state EHDI program must have a successful data capture and tracking system in place to identify children through each step of the process. Arkansas's goal focuses on the development of a web-based information system (Electronic Registration of Arkansas Vital Events or ERAVE) that will accurately identify, match and collect data that is un-duplicated and individually identifiable for each infant born in the state.
