

Federal regulations require all CDL holders and applicants to certify how they operate a commercial motor vehicle when obtaining, renewing, transferring, or upgrading their CDL license. Those certifying a non-excepted type must submit their medical certificate to The Office of Driver Services and each subsequently issued medical certificate. If your medical certificate is only valid with a vision, diabetes or a skills performance evaluation variance granted by FMCSA, you must submit variance documents with your medical certificate, and each subsequently issued. All variances must display a "V restriction" on the CDL license. A "K restriction" must be displayed on the CDL license for Intrastate commerce.



Do you operate a CMV only for any excepted activities per 49 CFR 390.3 below?

- School bus operations
- As a federal, state or local government employee
- To transport sick, injured, or human corpses
- · Fire and rescue drivers involved in an emergency or related operation
- Transportation of propane winter heating fuel or responding to a pipeline emergency
- Custom-harvesting operations: transporting farm machinery, supplies to or from a farm or to transport custom
 harvested crops to storage or market
- Beekeeper in the seasonal transportation of bees
- Controlled and operated by a farmer to transport agricultural products, farm machinery, or farm supplies within 150 miles of the farm- Cannot be a combination vehicle (power unit and towed unit) and cannot transport placard-able hazardous materials
- As a private motor carrier of passengers for non-business purposes
- To transport migrant workers
- Occasional transportation of personal property not for compensation or commercial enterprise





MCSA-5876 is the only medical certificate accepted.

CDL holders cannot claim exemption from medical certification requirements because they are not currently operating in a non-excepted driving type. If not specifically included in type 2 or 4, you must maintain your medical certification or downgrade to a non-commercial license.
