## MINUTES OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD MARCH 16, 2016

On the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2016, the ABC Board did convene at Little Rock, Arkansas for its regular monthly meeting and in attendance were Janet Moore, Chairperson, Thomas P. Powell, Jr., Steve Smith, Jean Hervey, and Chris Palmer.

The Board considered the application of Ibrahim H. Elsaidi, Downtown Deli and Grocery, 314 East 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Little Rock, Retail Beer Off Premises – New and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to deny the Retail Beer On Premises Permit.

The Board considered the application of James Smith, Riverdale 10 Movie, 2600 Cantrell Road, Little Rock, On Premises Wine & Beer On Premises – request to extend operating hours and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to extend the operating hours but upheld the previous approval of a two drink limit.

The Board considered the application of Mark E. Camp, The 1836 Club, 1406 Cantrell Road, Little Rock, Private Club – New and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to grant the Private Club - New.

The Board considered the request to reduce the square footage of Jarret C. Clements retail liquor store and after considering all the facts in the case the Board voted 5-0 on the following: that Mr. Clements must construct a solid wall between the two businesses so that there is no possible access between them and is given thirty days in which to comply and Mr. Clements must change his signage to be approved by the ABC Director. The change shall make it clear that Parkway Liquor and Party Central are two completely distinct and separate businesses. Mr. Clements was given sixty days to submit his changes to the ABC Director and gain his approval. Once those conditions are satisfied, Mr. Clements may request final inspection. Mr. Clements has ninety days to acquire and install Director approve new signage and any failure to meet this deadline may result in revocation of permit.

The Board considered the application of Robert D. Perkins, Uncle Bob's Karaoke on Divoky, 3611 Divoky Road, Pine Bluff, Private Club – New and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to deny the Private Club application.

The Board accepted the Director's Decisions regarding the Violation Resume, Private Club Resume, Extension of Inactive Status, Warning Letters and the Director's Resume.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting of the alcoholic Beverage Control Board is scheduled for April 20, 2016.
