

**MINUTES OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD
SEPTEMBER 17, 2016**

On the 21st day of September, 2016, the ABC Board did convene at Little Rock, Arkansas for its regular monthly meeting and in attendance were Janet Moore, Chairperson, Thomas P. Powell, Jr., Steve Smith, Jean Hervey, and Chris Palmer.

Pulaski County Circuit Court remanded William C. Goolsby, Southside Liquor, 23233 I-30 South, Suite 31, Bryant, Retail Liquor – New, back to the ABC Board. The Board voted 4-1 to amended their September 16, 2015, Board Decision and Findings of Fact and granted the Retail Liquor Permit.

The Board considered the application of Juan C. Aguilar, Main Street Pizza of Walnut Ridge, Private Club – New and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to grant the Private Club Permit.

The Board considered the application of S. Christian Flanagan, Beaver Dam Store, 8421 Highway 187, Eureka Springs, Retail Liquor & Beer Off Premises – Replacement & Transfer of Location; Granted Conditional July 20, 2016, Administrative Hearing held on June 28, 2016, regarding the amended floorplan. The Board granted the request to leave the door as an emergency door. Mr. Flannagin stated that he would have a sign on the outside of the door stating that no entry is allowed and that he would have a latch door on the inside with a sign stating that no exit can be had through the door. That this door would be used to exit the liquor store only in case of a true emergency and that his attendant would have a key to the door. The Board finds that Mr. Flanagan's request will not violate ACA § 3-4-218 or Section 1.33(2) of the ABC Regulations. The Board voted 5-0 to Grant the request.

The Board considered the application of Laura A. Moran, World Event Center, 1902 South 8th, Suites 9-14, Rogers, Large Attendance Facility – New, and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to grant the Large Attendance Facility Permit.

Mary Robin Casteel presented a request from National Restaurant Association to provide a Responsible Alcohol Service Servsafe Alcohol Program for the employees of permitted establishments in the state. The Board voted 5-0 to grant their request.

The Board accepted the Director's Decisions regarding the Violation Resume, Private Club Resume, Extension of Inactive Status and the Director's Resume.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting of the alcoholic Beverage Control Board is scheduled for October 19, 2016.
