The Board considered the application of Abel R. Benavidez, Taqueria Mariscoc, 7102 Colonel Glenn Road, Little Rock, Retail Beer On Premises – New and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to grant the Retail Beer On Premises Permits.

The Board reviewed the appeal of Retail Beer Off Premises and Small Farm Wine – Retail Permit No. 06740, Amina Ali, Roland Mart, 7808 Highway 300, Roland and after considering all of the facts in the case, the Board voted 5-0 to suspend the sale of alcoholic beverages for a period of six (6) months. At the end of the six (6) month. The permittee will be reissued a permit for allowing the sale of beer and small farm wine.

The Board accepted the Director's Decisions regarding the Violation Resume, Private Club Resume, Extension of Inactive Status and the Director's Resume.
